

The Delton Area Rotary Scholarship

The Delton Area Rotary will award scholarships to be used for books and supplies in the year 2010. Scholarships will continue until the award has been used or for 4 years whichever comes first.

Any high school senior may apply who meets the following requirements:

1. Must have resided in the Delton-Kellogg School District for two school years;
2. Attend any accredited college, vocational school or institution of higher learning within one year of graduation from any school in the District.

Criteria of Selection:

1. Financial Need
2. Scholarship (Grade point 2.5 minimum)
3. Citizenship (*Exhibiting loyalty and respect to school, community, state and country.*)
4. Leadership
5. Extracurricular activities
6. School/community service

Application Process: (Complete all four items.)

1. Complete the Delton Area Rotary Scholarship Application 2010 Form.
2. Submit your high school transcript and SAT and/or ACT score documentation.
3. In essay form (250 words or more), write about yourself, your ambitions and your financial need, including information from each of areas in the "Criteria for Selection" listed above.
 - The Rotary motto is "Service Above Self." Be sure to include information about how you may have already lived out that motto in your life and how that motto may be lived out in your future endeavors.
4. Provide three (3) letters of recommendation; one of which must come from school staff.

Deadline: Application must be received by your high school counselor no later than **Thursday, April 15, 2010.** Or postmarked no later than Wednesday, April 14, 2010. (No fax or e-mail applications will be accepted.)
