Multiple pages (minimum of four

Various fonts and colors

Five links to other pages

A widget (same thing as a gadget

Either video or sound (Remember, you must save the video file or sound file in the folder for your webpage

1. Determine a topic for your next webpage.
2. Determine topics for each subpage
3. Using Adobe Photoshop, begin working on your "header" for the next website
4. It must include a title and a minimum of one picture.
5. The more appealing and creative, the higher the grade
6. All of the pictures and the header will need to be saved in a folder titled "Header".
7. The gmail page will be graded today. The grade entered at the end of the day will be your grade for the page. You may add for this page later, but this grade will remain.
