This class is designed to present a basic understanding for students in creating web pages. Webpage creation will be explored in template based web design, Microsoft Frontpage and Microsoft Expressions and Dreamweaver There will also be a brief exposure to html. Uploading and posting websites will also be covered. The ethics of publishing webpages as well as the authenticity and authoritativeness of various web sites will be evaluated.

The class grade will consist of the following:

- 5 % - Class participation
- 15% - Daily class assignments and quizzes
- 60% - Four major projects – 15% each
- 20% - Final

Basic rules:

- Any posting of inappropriate material or information will result in failure of the course.
- An e-mail account is necessary for the class. Existing e-mails may be used. If a student does not have a current e-mail, they may use yahoo or gmail accounts.

- All major projects can be altered, added to or improved for additional credit up to the last day before finals. Any changes made require that Mrs. Culbert be notified by e-mail to note any changes. These e-mails must all include **WEB DESIGN – 2<sup>nd</sup> Tri** in the subject line.
- Certain aspects of the projects will be given separate grades. These will be given a due date. If the work is not completed by the due date, there will be a 10% reduction for each day late on the assignment.
- Students are expected to remain on task. Minimum effort will result in a minimum grade. The quality of projects will be graded on all of the minimum requirements for each assignment, originality, creativity, overall appearance and the final uploading of each project.
